5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to appropriate the sum of \$90,250.00
7 for the operating expenses of the Legisla-
8 ture; and setting an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. APPROPRIATION. That the sum of \$90,250.00 or so
11 much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated
12 out of the monies in the Treasury of the State of Alaska not
13 otherwise appropriated for the payment of the operating expenses
14 of the Legislature, said sums to be apportioned according to the
15 following schedules:

16 (1) For the daily compensation of the following legis-
17 lative employees for the number of days and in the amounts in-
18 dicated:

17 The total of any unused balances herein shall be divided by the
18 House of Representatives and the Senate for use in defraying any
19 contingencies authorized by the Speaker of the House or Represen-
20 tatives or the President of the Senate, respectively.

21 (2) For special contract bill drafting and consult-
22 ing legal services to the Legislature through the Legislative
23 Council providing two attorney-draftsmen, a special research
24 assistant, and two secretaries for approximately 60 days,
25 together with a research assistant; the sum of \$6,500.00.

26 (3) For the payment of necessary telephone service
27 for use of the Legislature during the present session; the
28 sum of \$150.00.

29 (4) For the purchase of legislative supplies and

1 materials as may be necessary for the use of the Legislature
2 during the present session; the sum of \$10,000.00

3 (5) For the payment of salaries incidental to the
4 special work of committees; the sum of \$1,000.00.

5 (6) For the preparing and the printing and binding
6 of the Session Laws and advance sheets; and the printing and
7 furnishing of stationery and other printing for the use of the
8 Legislature during the present session; the sum of \$17,000.00.

9 Sec. 2. MANNER OF PAYMENT. The monies hereby appropriated
10 shall be paid by warrants drawn on vouchers certified by the
11 bonded Legislative Fiscal Officer.

12 Sec. 3. UNENCUMBERED BALANCES. With the exception of those
13 funds the disposition of which is set forth in paragraph (1) Sec.
14 1 hereof, all unencumbered and unused balances herein shall re-
15 vert to the General Fund.

16 Sec. 4. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its
17 passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
