SENATE BILL NO.33

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting the purchase of intoxicating beverages without a liquor permit; prohibiting selling, bartering or trading of intoxicating beverages to any person not possessing a liquor permit; defining intoxicating beverage; setting forth the form and contents of said "Liquor Permit"; providing that said "Liquor Permit" be encased in a covering; prohibiting the issuance of a "Liquor Permit" to persons under 21 years of age and certain others; providing for the revocation of "Liquor Permits" by certain courts for certain periods upon certain conditions; providing for the issuance of "Liquor Permits" under the direction of the Governor; requiring that "Liquor Permits" be issued to persons fulfilling certain requirements; providing for the issuance of temporary "Liquor Permits" and the mailing of "Liquor Permit" to applicants; providing that photographs and fingerprints be forwarded to the State Police; providing for the invalidation of "Liquor Permit" after one year; prohibiting the use of another's

1 "Liquor Permit" or allowing another to use
2 one's "Liquor Permit"; providing for a
3 penalty for breach of this Act; authorizing
4 the Governor to allow others to issue liquor
5 permits and their compensation; providing for
6 the disposal of fees collected; authorizing
7 the sum of \$10,000.00 for the administration
8 of this Act; and setting an effective date."

9 Section 1. No person shall purchase any form of intoxicating
10 beverage unless such person shall have first procured a "Liquor
11 Permit".

12 Section 2. No person shall trade, barter or sell an intoxi-
13 cating beverage to any other person, unless such purchaser shall
14 possess and present for the seller's inspection a validated
15 "Liquor Permit".

16 Section 3. As provided herein, an intoxicating beverage shall
17 mean any potable liquid containing more than one-half of one per-
18 centum (1/2%) alcohol by volume.

19 Section 4. The "Liquor Permit" herein referred to shall be
20 in the following form:

21 (a) A paper card two (2) inches high and four (4)
22 inches long;

23 (b) The color of said card shall be yellow;

24 (c) The front of said card shall bear the following
25 legend:

consume intoxicating beverages in the State of Alaska in conformance with the laws therein appertaining.

Section 5. Said "Liquor Permit" shall be encased in a clear transparent covering of such nature that it cannot be altered without being destroyed.

Section 6. Said permit shall not be issued to any person who has not attained his 21st birthday nor to any person whose right thereto has been revoked by a court as hereinafter provided.

Section 7. All duly constituted courts in this state shall have the authority to revoke any person's right to have and possess said "Liquor Permit" for a period of three (3) years or any part thereof, upon said court finding, in a case regularly before it, that said person has neglected a duty or committed a triable offense by reason of intoxication.

Section 8. The "Liquor Permit" herein provided shall be issued by the Governor or any Department of the State designated by the Governor to do so.

Section 9. Said "Liquor Permit" shall be issued, except as otherwise provided, upon the applicant presenting a photograph of himself to any issuing officer, and an application in which he

1 states his true name, age, sex, occupation, and address, together
2 with the sum of Two (\$2.00) Dollars.

3 Section 10. If it is not convenient to deliver the "Liquor
4 Permit" at the time application is made, the issuing officer
5 shall immediately present the applicant with a thirty (30) day
6 "Temporary Liquor Permit" containing no photograph; in which
7 case said "Liquor Permit" shall be mailed to said applicant as
8 directed.

9 Section 11. A copy of the photograph and fingerprint of
10 every applicant shall be forwarded to the headquarters of the
11 State Police for permanent public identification.

12 Section 12. Every "Liquor Permit", unless otherwise invali-
13 dated, shall become void one (1) year after application for same
14 has been made.

15 Section 13. No person shall use the "Liquor Permit" of
16 another, nor shall any person allow another to use a "Liquor
17 Permit" issued to him.

18 Section 14. Any person violating any provision of this Act
19 shall be guilty of misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall
20 be fined not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars and/or by
21 confinement in jail for a period of not more than ninety (90)
22 days.

23 Section 15. The Governor may direct that private persons
24 issue said "Liquor Permits" under such terms and conditions as he
25 shall provide, in which case the Governor is authorized to pay
26 said persons the sum of fifty cents (50¢) out of the fee collect-
27 ed from each applicant.

28 Section 16. All monies collected under the provisions of
29 this Act, except as otherwise provided, shall be deposited in

1 the General Fund of the State Treasury.

2 Section 17. The sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars is
3 hereby authorized out of any monies in the General Fund not other-
4 wise appropriated for the purpose of administering the provisions
5 of this Act.

6 Section 18. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its
7 passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such
8 approval.
