6 For an Act entitled: "An Act pertaining to legal holidays;
7 amending and clarifying Sec. 1-1-6, ACLA
8 1949."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Section 1-1-6, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to
11 read as follows:

12 Sec. 1-1-6. LEGAL HOLIDAYS. The following days are
13 legal holidays, namely: SUNDAY; the first day of January,
14 commonly called New Year's Day; the twelfth day of February,
15 commonly called Lincoln's birthday; the twenty-second day
16 of February, commonly called Washington's birthday; the
17 thirtieth day of March, to be called Seward's Day in
18 commemoration of the signing of the treaty ceding Alaska
19 to the United States; the fourth day of July, commonly called
20 Independence Day; the first Monday in September, commonly
21 called Labor Day; the eighteenth day of October, commonly
22 called Alaska Day; the eleventh day of November, commonly
23 called Veterans' ARMISTICE Day; the twenty-fifth day of
24 December, commonly called Christmas Day; and any day
25 designated by public proclamation by the President of the
26 United States or the Governor of the State TERRITORY of
27 Alaska, as a legal holiday, or as a day of Thanksgiving; and
28 the day known and observed as Memorial or Decoration Day.
29 AND THE DAY ON WHICH A GENERAL ELECTION IS HELD THROUGHOUT
