SENATE BILL NO. 39

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act making it a misdemeanor to serve intoxicating liquor to minors; providing penalties for any violations thereof; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. GIVING OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR TO MINORS. Any person or firm, company, corporation or any employee thereof who shall sell, barter, give or deliver to any person under the age of twenty-one years, any intoxicating liquor or beverage shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by imprisonment of not more than one year, or by a fine of not more than five hundred (\$500.00) dollars, or both.

The term "person" as used herein shall not include a parent, guardian or other responsible relative or any licensed physician or nurse. The term "intoxicating liquor" shall be deemed to include whiskey, brandy, rum, gin, wine, ale, porter, beer and all other spiritous, vinous, malt and other fermented or distilled liquors intended for human consumption and containing more than one percent (1%) alcohol by volume.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
