6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making it a misdemeanor to serve  
7 intoxicating liquor to minors; providing  
8 penalties for any violations thereof; and  
9 providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. GIVING OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR TO MINORS. Any  
12 person or firm, company, corporation or any employee thereof  
13 who shall sell, barter, give or deliver to any person under the  
14 age of twenty-one years, any intoxicating liquor or beverage  
15 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof  
16 shall be punished by imprisonment of not more than one year, or  
17 by a fine of not more than five hundred (\$500.00) dollars, or both.

18 The term "person" as used herein shall not include a parent  
19 as to his own minor child, a guardian as to his ward or any  
20 licensed physician or nurse in giving medical treatment. The term  
21 "intoxicating liquor" shall be deemed to include whiskey, brandy,  
22 rum, gin, wine, ale, porter, beer and all other spiritous, vinous,  
23 malt and other fermented or distilled liquors intended for human  
24 consumption and containing more than one percent (1%) alcohol by  
25 volume.

26 Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its  
27 passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
