A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making it a misdemeanor to serve
7 intoxicating liquor to persons under the age
8 of twenty-one years; providing penalties for
9 any violations thereof; and providing for
10 an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. GIVING OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR TO PERSONS UNDER
13 THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE YEARS. Any person or firm, company, corp-
14 oration or any employee thereof who shall sell, barter, give or
15 deliver to any person under the age of twenty-one years, any intox-
16 icating liquor or beverage shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and
17 upon conviction thereof shall be punished by imprisonment of not
18 more than one year, or by a fine of not more than five hundred
19 (\$500.00) dollars, or both.

20 The term "person" as used herein shall not include a parent
21 as to his own child, a guardian as to his ward or any licensed
22 physician or nurse in giving medical treatment. The term "intox-
23 icating liquor" shall be deemed to include whiskey, brandy, rum,
24 gin, wine, ale, porter, beer and all other spiritous, vinous, malt
25 and other fermented or distilled liquors intended for human con-
26 sumption and containing more than one percent (1%) alcohol by volume.

27 Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its
28 passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
