



1 editorial work, the indexing, printing and binding of such Code  
2 to the bidder more nearly meeting the requirements of the State  
3 of Alaska, as determined by the Governor, or his representative,  
4 and he is hereby authorized to accept a bid at terms to best serve  
5 the interests of the state, subject, however, to the provisions  
6 of this Act as hereinafter set forth. All bids may be rejected.  
7 Bids may be solicited for 1,000, 1,500, and 2,000 sets of the  
8 State Code.

9 (3) The company to which the contract is awarded shall  
10 specify and agree in the contract that all of the editorial work  
11 with the exception of the general index, shall be completed and  
12 ready for inspection and review by the Governor and the Legislative  
13 Council not later than six months after the legislative acts are  
14 furnished the company, and must further specify and agree that  
15 five (5) sets of galley proofs of the entire Code, with the excep-  
16 tion of the general index, shall be completed and ready for  
17 delivery to the state no later than eleven months after the company  
18 has received the complete set of legislative acts.

19 The company to which is awarded the contract shall likewise  
20 contract and agree and guarantee to keep the Code in print for  
21 twenty-five (25) years and to this end it shall either hold the  
22 type, plates or matrices from which the printing is done, so that  
23 other and additional sets may be ordered by the state from time to  
24 time.

25 The publisher shall also post a performance bond, with surety,  
26 satisfactory to the Governor, or his representative, guaranteeing  
27 the faithful performance of the provisions of the contract.

28 (4) The contract shall provide for the delivery to the  
29 Commissioner of Administration of the State of Alaska of 1,000,

1 1,500, or 2,000 sets of the State Code, whichever quantity is  
2 determined to be in the best interests of the State, said sets to  
3 be supplied, including delivery at Juneau or as directed by the  
4 Commissioner as part of the contract price.

5 (5) A proposed schedule of distribution to state  
6 agencies shall be submitted to the legislature.

7 Sec. 2. All disbursements of any funds authorized for the  
8 purposes of this Act shall be made on vouchers approved by the  
9 Executive Director of the Legislative Council.

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
