BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. SALARY OF GOVERNOR AND SECRETARY OF STATE: FULL  
COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES. The annual compensation fixed by law  
for the Governor and Secretary of State shall be in full for all  
services by them respectively rendered in any official capacity  
or employment whatsoever during their respective terms of office,  
and shall be paid throughout their respective terms of office  
unless such office or offices become vacant.

Sec. 2. EXCLUSION OF GOVERNOR AND SECRETARY OF STATE FROM  
STATE PERSONNEL LAWS. Notwithstanding the provisions of any  
other law, the Governor and Secretary of State are not to be  
deemed employees of the state for the purpose of state personnel  
laws relating to the hours of employment, annual leave, sick  
leave, overtime, compensatory time, and travel allowances, of  
such employees. Nothing herein shall be construed to deprive  
the Governor and Secretary of State, respectively, of the right  
to participate in the state retirement system or in state group  
insurance plans.

Sec. 3. SUBSEQUENT LEGISLATION. The provisions of this  
Act shall not be superseded or modified by any subsequent

1 legislation except to the extent that such legislation shall do  
2 so expressly.

3       Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall take effect  
4 immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming  
5 law without such approval.
