FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act permitting cities, school districts and public utility districts to collect unpaid sales, personal property and other taxes and fees by means of the remedy of distraint as it is exercised by the State Tax Commissioner; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Cities, school districts and public utility districts are hereby empowered, by means of ordinance or resolution duly enacted by their governing bodies, to collect delinquent sales taxes and personal property taxes by means of the remedy of distraint, using the procedures that the said taxing agencies find applicable in Section 12 (D) of Chapter 115, SLA 1949, as amended.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
