IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act limiting the bringing of actions against political subdivisions, public and private corporations, cooperatives, associations and others by reason of the maintenance of electric transmission or distribution lines or telephone lines on real property."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provision of any other law, no action or suit may be brought against any political subdivision, corporation, municipal or otherwise, company, cooperative, individual or association of individuals doing business in this state, or against any agent, servant or employee thereof, by reason of the maintenance of electric transmission or distribution lines or telephone lines, on any real property after the expiration of a period of two years of continuous maintenance of such lines.
