IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act pertaining to the oath of office of state officers and employees; repealing Sec. 11-1-8, ACLA 1949 as amended by Ch. 113, SLA 1949; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. All public officers and employees of the State of Alaska, before entering upon the duties of their offices, shall take and subscribe to the following oath or affirmation:

"I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support and defend the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of Alaska, and that I will faithfully discharge my duties as _____ to the best of my ability."

Sec. 2. Sec. 11-1-8, ACLA 1949 as amended by Ch. 113, SLA 1949 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
