6 For an Act entitled: "An Act empowering city councils of cities
7 of the first class to recover the costs
8 of maintaining public works constructed by
9 the Alaska Highway and Public Works Depart-
10 ment; amending Sec. 16-1-35, ACLA 1949, as
11 amended by Chapters 38, 91, and 92 of SLA
12 1949, Chapters 47 and 61 of SLA 1951,
13 Chapters 27, 28, 44, 118, and 121 of SLA
14 1953, Chapters 28, 51, and 67 of SLA 1955,
15 and Chapters 25, 94, 101, 109, 124, 151, 153
16 and 156 of SLA 1957 by adding a new sub-
17 section; and providing for an effective
18 date."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

20 Section 1. Sec. 16-1-35, ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapters
21 38, 91, and 92 of SLA 1949, Chapters 47 and 61 of SLA 1951,
22 Chapters 27, 28, 44, 118, and 121 of SLA 1953, Chapters 28, 51,
23 and 67 of SLA 1955, and Chapters 25, 94, 101, 109, 124, 151, 153,
24 and 156 of SLA 1957, is hereby amended by adding thereto subsection
25 31, to read as follows:

26 N Subsection 31. To recover the costs to the city
27 of furnishing services to facilities constructed or maintained
28 E within the boundaries of the incorporated municipality by
29 W by the Alaska Highway and Public Works Department or its

successor to the function of constructing such facilities,
including in such services, but not limited to, furnishing
supervision, repairs, lights, water, snow removal and other
services incidental to the operation of such facilities.
The recovery of such costs shall be by ordinance establishing
reasonable rates to be charged and collected by the city for
furnishing such services; provided, that the monies so re-
covered shall be accounted separately by the city and shall
be expended on furnishing such services, and, in the event
that the charges so assessed are greater than the cost of
such services, the excess shall be expended only on improving
or refurbishing such facilities. Collection of such charges,
and penalties for failure to pay such charges, shall be as
prescribed by ordinance.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon
its passage and approval, or upon its becoming law without such
approval.
