SENATE BILL NO. 130

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing and directing the Governor to continue payments under the amended Temporary Unemployment Compensation Act, and providing an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. It is declared to be the policy of the State to cooperate with the Federal Government in nation-wide efforts to combat major economic recessions and depressions. Consistent with this policy, the Legislature recognizes the necessity of widespread state participation in the Federal temporary unemployment compensation program as enacted in 1958 and as it may hereafter be amended.

Sec. 2. The Governor of Alaska is hereby authorized and directed to take such steps as may be necessary to provide for the continued payment of temporary unemployment compensation benefits by the State in cooperation with the Federal Government under the Temporary Unemployment Compensation Act as extended by Public Law 7, 86th Congress and as said Act may hereafter be extended.

Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
