6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to per diem and trans-
7 portation for members of state boards,
8 commissions, committees and councils;
9 amending Ch. 130, SLA 1953; and providing
10 for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Sec. 1, Ch. 130, SLA 1953 is amended to read as
13 follows:

14 Section 1. From and after the effective date of
15 this Act, the following provisions relating to per diem
16 and transportation shall govern exclusively, and shall
17 supersede all other provisions of law, with respect to a
18 member of any state [TERRITORIAL] board, commission,
19 committee, judicial council, or other similar body of persons
20 of the state [TERRITORY] organized or established under the
21 authority of law, but excluding all other [TERRITORIAL]
22 state employees, who is otherwise entitled by law to receive
23 from the state [TERRITORY] payments for expenses of trans-
24 portation and for reimbursement, or for per diem in lieu of
25 reimbursement, for other expenses, incident to his duties as
26 such member:

27 (a) With respect to transportation, such member shall
28 be entitled either to the use of state [TERRITORIAL] trans-
29 portation requests, or to be reimbursed for expenses of

transportation, to the same extent, in the same manner and under the same conditions as provided for state [TERRITORIAL] officials and employees by the provisions of [SUBSECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF] Section 11-4-1, ACLA 1949, as amended or as hereafter amended.

(b) With respect to reimbursements for other expenses, such member shall be entitled to per diem and compensation, the combination of which shall be at the rate of \$35.00 [\$20.00] per day for each day, or portion thereof, spent in actual meeting or on authorized official business incident to his duties as such member.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
