6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing exemptions from motor
7 vehicle licensing and registration and from
8 operator's licensing; amending subsec. (1),
9 Sec. 8, Ch. 124, SLA 1951 and Sec. 3, Ch.
10 173, SLA 1959."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Subsec. (1), Sec. 8, Ch. 124, SLA 1951 is amended
13 to read as follows:

14 (1) PLEASURE VEHICLES. Any person who shall bring
15 into the state [TERRITORY] a vehicle of the type required
16 to be registered hereunder which is duly registered in any
17 other state and who shall use such vehicle for pleasure only,
18 shall be exempt from the licensing and registration pro-
19 visions of this act for a period of ninety days after entry
20 into the state [TERRITORY] , or if a high-school or college
21 student on vacation, for the period from June 1 through
22 September 30; provided, however, that such exemption shall
23 not apply if such person , other than a high-school or coll-
24 ege student on vacation, becomes gainfully employed in the
25 state [TERRITORY] or takes any action to indicate his in-
26 tention to acquire residence in the state [TERRITORY].

27 Sec. 2. Sec. 3, Ch. 173, SLA 1959 is amended by adding a
28 new subsection (4) to read as follows:

29 (4) During the period from June 1 through

September 30, any nonresident high-school or college student on vacation who is 16 years of age or older and who holds a valid operator's license from another state.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
