6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to scholarships for certain
7 native students; amending Sec. 3, Ch. 140,
8 SLA 1955."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Sec. 3, Ch. 140, SLA 1955 is amended to read as
11 follows:

12 Section 3. SCHOLARSHIPS. The Board of Regents of the
13 University of Alaska shall offer scholarships to Alaskan
14 natives desiring to attend the University of Alaska, not to
15 exceed 15 [TEN] new scholarships for each academic year.
16 Preference shall be given to natives residing in the rural
17 areas of Alaska who desire to receive training in the field
18 [DEPARTMENT] of Education. If there are more than 15 [TEN]
19 applications the Board of Regents shall award 15 [TEN] scholar-
20 ships to those applicants who have the highest scholastic re-
21 cord or who are determined by the Board of Regents to be the
22 most qualified among the applicants and who are financially
23 unable to obtain a higher education without assistance. The
24 University shall provide such minimum financial assistance to
25 such students as shall be necessary in each individual case,
26 but not to exceed fees, board and room in any case.
