FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to power of eminent domain of the Alaska State Housing Authority; amending Sec. 8, Ch. 105, SLA 1951; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 8, Ch. 105, SLA 1951 is amended to read as follows:

Section 8. EMINENT DOMAIN. The Authority shall have the right to acquire by the exercise of the power of eminent domain any real property which it may deem necessary within the boundaries of a redevelopment project or for its purposes under this Act after the adoption by it of a resolution declaring that the acquisition of the real property described therein is necessary for such purposes. The Authority may exercise the power of eminent domain in the manner provided in Secs. 57-7-1 to 57-7-23 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1949, as supplemented and amended by Ch. 90, SLA 1953, as amended by Ch. 138, SLA 1955 and Ch. 146, SLA 1959, and acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, or it may exercise the power of eminent domain in the manner now or which may be hereafter provided by any statutory provisions for the exercise of the power of eminent domain. Property already devoted to a public use may be acquired in a like manner, provided that no real property belonging to the

municipality or the state [TERRITORY] may be acquired without its consent.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
