6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to power of eminent domain
7 of the Alaska State Housing Authority; amend-
8 ing Sec. 8, Ch. 105, SLA 1951; and providing
9 for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 8, Ch. 105, SLA 1951 is amended to read
12 as follows:

13 Section 8. EMINENT DOMAIN. The Authority shall have
14 the right to acquire by the exercise of the power of eminent
15 domain any real property which it may deem necessary within
16 the boundaries of a redevelopment project or for its purposes
17 under this Act after the adoption by it of a resolution
18 declaring that the acquisition of the real property described
19 therein is necessary for such purposes. The Authority may
20 exercise the power of eminent domain in the manner provided
21 in Secs. 57-7-1 to 57-7-23 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska,
22 1949, as supplemented and amended by Ch. 90, SLA 1953, as
23 amended by Ch. 138, SLA 1955 and Ch. 146, SLA 1959, and acts
24 amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, or it may
25 exercise the power of eminent domain in the manner now or
26 which may be hereafter provided by any statutory provisions
27 for the exercise of the power of eminent domain. Property
28 already devoted to a public use may be acquired in a like
29 manner, provided that no real property belonging to the

municipality or the state [TERRITORY] may be acquired without its consent.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
