SENATE BILL NO. 182

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the custody and misuse of the seal of the State of Alaska."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The secretary of state is the custodian of the seal of the State of Alaska.

Sec. 2. Any person who, with intent to defraud, forges, counterfeits, or uses without authorization the seal of the State of Alaska or a replica or reproduction of the seal, or who, with intent to defraud, falsely makes, forges, or counterfeits any impression purporting to be the impression of the seal is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined by a sum not to exceed \$500.00 or imprisoned for a period not to exceed six months or by both.
