For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of explo-  
7 sives handlers; amending Subsecs. (a) and  
8 (c) of Ch. 120, Sec. 1, SLA 1955, and pro-  
9 viding for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Subsections (a) and (c) of Ch. 120, Sec. 1, SLA

12

1955, are amended to read as follows:

13

(a) Certificate of fitness shall be issued by the

14

Commissioner of Labor [COMMISSIONER OF MINES] and shall

15

be issued only to individuals. All applications for such

16

certificates of fitness shall be made in writing, and

17

verified, and shall state (1) the name and address of the

18

applicant, (2) his age, (3) his citizenship, and (4) any

19

other information which the Commissioner of Labor [COMMIS-

20

SIONER OF MINES] may require. Having determined, upon

21

investigation and examination, that the applicant is com-

22

petent by reason of training and experience, the Commis-

23

sioner of Labor [COMMISSIONER OF MINES] shall issue a

24

certificate of fitness. The certificate of fitness shall

25

set forth the competency of the individual to whom it is

26

issued, shall provide for his positive identification,

27

and shall be carried on the person engaged in handling

28

explosives. Applicants for certificates of fitness will

29

submit a fee of \$5.00 with their application, and certi-

fications issued will remain in effect unless cancelled for cause.

(c) The Commissioner of Labor ~~COMMISSIONER OF MINES~~ shall have the power to issue all orders, rules and regulations relating to the storage and use of explosives necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
