For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the incorporation of
7 first class cities; amending Sec. 16-1-4,
8 ACLA 1949; and providing for an effective
9 date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 16-1-4, ACLA 1949, is amended to read as

12

follows:

Sec. 16-1-4. ORDER ADJUDGING AND DECLARING INCORPORA-

14

TION: FILING SAME. If it shall appear from the said certi-

15

ficate of election filed with the clerk of the superior court,

16

[DISTRICT COURT, AS AFORESAID,] that a majority [TWO THIRDS]

17

or more of the votes cast at said election were in favor of

18

the incorporation and that the provisions of law relating to

19

incorporation have been substantially complied with, then

20

the district judge shall, by an order in writing entered in

21

the records of the court, duly adjudge and declare that the

22

community in which such election has been held is and shall

23

be deemed to be a municipal corporation under the name of

24

"the city of (here insert the name)," and the same shall

25

from thenceforth be deemed a municipal corporation possessed

26

of the powers and privileges hereinafter prescribed, and such

27

other powers as may be given by law. Such order shall des-

28

cribe the boundaries and give the name of the corporation,

and one certified copy thereof shall be filed in the office

of the Secretary of State [THE TERRITORY] and another in
the office of the magistrate [COMMISSIONER] of the district
[PRECINCT] in which the corporation is situated.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
