For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the incorporation of  
7 first class cities; amending Sec. 16-1-4,  
8 ACLA 1949; and providing for an effective  
9 date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 16-1-4, ACLA 1949, is amended to read as

12

follows:

Sec. 16-1-4, ORDER ADJUDGING AND DECLARING INCORPORA-

14

TION: FILING SAME. If it shall appear from the said certi-

15

ficate of election filed with the clerk of the superior court,

16

[DISTRICT COURT, AS AFORESAID,] that a majority [TWO THIRDS

17

OR MORE] of the votes cast at said election were in favor of

18

the incorporation and that the provisions of law relating to

19

incorporation have been substantially complied with, then

20

the superior court [DISTRICT] judge shall, by an order in

21

writing entered in the records of the court, duly adjudge and

22

declare that the community in which such election has been

23

held is and shall be deemed to be a municipal corporation

24

under the name of "the city of (here insert the name)," and

25

the same shall from thenceforth be deemed a municipal corp-

26

oration possessed of the powers and privileges hereinafter

27

prescribed, and such other powers as may be given by law.

Such order shall describe the boundaries and give the name

29

of the corporation, and one certified copy thereof shall be

filed in the office of the Secretary of State [THE TERRITORY]  
and another in the office of the magistrate [COMMISSIONER] of  
the district [PRECINCT] in which the corporation is situated.  
Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
