SENATE BILL NO. 237

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the Commissioner of Public Safety to contract with political subdivisions for the furnishing of police services to such political subdivisions; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. In the event a political subdivision is unable to provide adequate police protection, the Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety may contract with such political subdivision to provide sufficient personnel to secure proper policing of such political subdivision.

The commissioner may charge such political subdivision with the entire cost thereof, or any portion of the entire cost as he may determine. Such charge may be deducted from any grant payable out of state funds to such political subdivision.

The commissioner may station any member or members of the Division of State Police or Alaska State Constabulary in such political subdivision for the purpose of providing such police protection.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
