SENATE BILL NO. 238

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting the unauthorized possession of nuclear devices; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. No person, persons, corporation, or governmental agency shall prepare or attempt to detonate any thermonuclear device or shall possess any thermonuclear device with intent to detonate the same within the territorial limits of the State of Alaska without the express authorization of the Governor of the State of Alaska, or the Legislature, when in session, by majority vote, unless the President of the United States signifies in writing to the Governor that the contemplated explosion is necessary to national security.

Sec. 2. The Attorney General shall commence proceedings, in the name of the State of Alaska, in the Superior Court or in such other court or courts having jurisdiction over such proceedings to abate and enjoin any such detonation, preparation or attempt.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
