BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 65-2-2, ACLA 1949 as amended by Sec. 3,

Ch. 132, SLA 1957, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 65-2-2. DIVISION OF CRIMES: "FELONIES" AND

15

"MISDEMEANORS" DEFINED. That crimes are divided into

16

felonies and misdemeanors. A felony is a crime which is

17

or may be punishable by imprisonment for a period exceeding

18

one year [IN THE PENITENTIARY]. Every other crime is a

19

misdemeanor.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage

21

and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
