SENATE BILL NO. 258

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to provide for the construction of the terms "United States Marshal" and "United States Attorney" in statutes relating to the obligations of these persons as public officials; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety, or any member of the Division of State Police designated by him, is hereby authorized to undertake and perform all of the obligations and duties imposed upon the United States Marshal and his deputies by the various statutes effective within the state and wherever such statutes make reference to the United States Marshal, and his deputies, such reference shall be construed to mean exclusively the Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety, or any member of the Division of State Police, or other police or peace officer designated by him.

Sec. 2. The Attorney General, any Deputy or Assistant Attorney General, and any District Attorney appointed by the Attorney General, is hereby authorized to undertake and perform all of the obligations and duties imposed upon the United States Attorney and his assistants by the various statutes effective within the state and wherever such statutes make reference to the United States Attorney and his assistants, or the District

1 Attorney, such reference shall be construed to mean exclusively
2 the Attorney General, any Deputy or Assistant Attorney General,
3 or any District Attorney appointed by the Attorney General.

4 Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect on the day after its
5 passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such
6 approval.
