2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 6

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the name of a certain city

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN FIRST
7 SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING:

8 WHEREAS, there is located at the confluence of the Tanana
9 and Chena Rivers in this state a city of pride and prosperity
10 which has long been suffering under the burden of a non-indigenous
11 name; and

12 WHEREAS, this fair city located approximately 130 miles south
13 of the Arctic Circle with an approximate elevation of 448 feet and
14 being the chief town of central Alaska, port of entry, and rail-
15 road terminus, deserves an appellation compatible with its history
16 and Alaskan setting; and

17 WHEREAS, as an instrumentality of the state this city has
18 a right to expect and receive the full support and direction of
19 the State Legislature, particularly in matters over which the city
20 is not able to take effective action;

21 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Legisla-
22 ture of the State of Alaska, the House concurring, that in res-
23 ponse to the pleas of the people of the aforementioned city for
24 freedom from the onus of a name forced upon them by an indifferent
25 and unfeeling federal government, the Legislature does hereby
26 endow said city with a name which is its natural inheritance --
27 Barnette's Cache.
