3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION  
6 ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

7 WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America will celebrate its golden  
8 anniversary during 1960, marking fifty years of service to the  
9 boys of the nation; and

10 WHEREAS, its program of character development, citizenship  
11 training, and physical fitness is recognized by the Alaskan people  
12 as being a distinct asset in the training of its youth; and

13 WHEREAS, the people of the State of Alaska recognize the  
14 important contribution to the state and the nation being made by  
15 the hundreds of thousands of volunteer adult leaders of Scouting  
16 who give of their time and resources to the leadership of Scouting  
17 units;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the State of Alaska that  
19 this Resolution expresses its commendation and support of the  
20 Boy Scouts of America and especially of its members and leaders  
21 in the State of Alaska; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be trans-  
23 mitted to the National Council of Boy Scouts of America and to  
24 its Southeastern Alaska and Western Alaska Councils.
