

1 IN THE SENATE BY SENATOR METCALF  
2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 18  
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to special regulations of the  
6 Alaska Board of Fish and Game, provid-  
7 ing for increased length of season for  
8 the hunting and taking of antlered  
9 bull moose on the east side of the  
10 Kenai Peninsula (Unit 7) during the  
11 year 1960.

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN FIRST LEG-  
13 ISLATURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
14 CONCURRING:

15 WHEREAS, the Alaska Board of Fish and Game has adopted game  
16 hunting regulations for the year 1960 providing for increasing  
17 the length of season for the hunting and taking of antlered bull  
18 moose on the east side of the Kenai Peninsula (Unit 7) from the  
19 customary annual season of August 20th through September 20th to  
20 the longer season of August 20th through September 30th plus the  
21 additional season of November 20th through November 30th, as set  
22 forth for Unit 7 under Sub-section Moose (1) antlered bulls of  
23 Section 311.02, Part 311 of Ch. 3 (Game) of Title 5, Alaska Game  
24 Regulations, 1960; and

25 WHEREAS, no public hearings whatsoever relative to local  
26 public opinion on this matter were held on the east side of the  
27 Kenai Peninsula (Unit 7) prior to the time of publishing the 1960  
28 Alaska Game Regulations providing for and establishing the seasons  
29 for the hunting and taking of antlered bull moose on the east

1 side of the Kenai Peninsula (Unit 7); and

2 WHEREAS, approximately 550 residents of the east side of the  
3 Kenai Peninsula (Unit 7), by means of a signed petition, have  
4 protested increasing the length of hunting seasons, as set forth  
5 in the 1960 game regulations for the hunting and taking of  
6 antlered bull moose on the east side of the Kenai Peninsula  
7 (Unit 7), feeling that, in the interest of conservation of game,  
8 the usual and customary annual moose hunting season of August 20th  
9 through September 20th is sufficient;

10 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in First Legislature, Second  
11 Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring that,  
12 in accordance with the provisions of Section 1, Article VII,  
13 Ch. 143, SLA 1959, the Administrative Procedure Act, that portion  
14 of the 1960 moose hunting regulations, providing for and per-  
15 mitting the hunting and taking of antlered bull moose on the east  
16 side of the Kenai Peninsula (Unit 7) during the time beyond the  
17 customary annual hunting season of August 20th through September  
18 20th be annulled.
