SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 20

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the construction of
roads.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, many starts have been made on road construction be-
tween points in Alaska which are now isolated one from another;
and

WHEREAS, the completion of these roads would greatly aid the
economic development of the immediate areas and the state at
large; and

WHEREAS, the state, in many cases, will be able to utilize
roadways and roadbeds already begun by private persons or by the
federal government; and

WHEREAS, it is our concern that every advantage be utilized
to connect the many isolated Alaskan communities by road whenever
such is practicable;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in First Legislature, Second
Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring, that
the construction of a road between Klawock and Hollis, between
Ugashik and Egegik, and between Eagle and Circle Hot Springs be
given high priority in the planning and development of the Alaska
road system and that if monies are not available for first class
roads that Pioneering Access roads be constructed; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be directed
to the Governor, the Commissioner of Public Works, and the

1 Director of the Division of Highways of the Department of Public
