5 Relating to the construction of
6 roads.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
8 ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS, many starts have been made on road construction be-
10 tween points in Alaska which are now isolated one from another;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, the completion of these roads would greatly aid the
13 economic development of the immediate areas and the state at
14 large; and

15 WHEREAS, the state, in many cases, will be able to utilize
16 roadways and roadbeds already begun by private persons or by the
17 federal government; and

18 WHEREAS, it is our concern that every advantage be utilized
19 to connect the many isolated Alaskan communities by road whenever
20 such is practicable;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in First Legislature, Second
22 Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring, that
23 the construction of a road between Klawock and Hollis, between
24 Ugashik and Egegik, be given high priority in the planning and
25 development of the Alaska road system and that if monies are not
26 available for first class roads that Pioneering Access roads be
27 constructed; and be it

28 FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be directed
29 to the Governor, the Commissioner of Public Works, and the

1 Director of the Division of Highways of the Department of Public
2 Works.
