2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 21  
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the Port of Whittier.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION  
7 ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

8 WHEREAS, there is every indication that the U. S. Army is  
9 going to abandon the Port of Whittier; and

10 WHEREAS, the state stands in good stead to receive the Port  
11 of Whittier from the federal government without charge; and

12 WHEREAS, since it is unknown whether acquisition of the Port  
13 of Whittier would be advantageous or disadvantageous, it certainly  
14 behoves the state to investigate the feasibility of acquiring the  
15 Port of Whittier; and

16 WHEREAS, the federal government may offer the Port of Whittier  
17 to the state at any time and the state should be prepared to  
18 accept or reject the offer;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in First Legislature, Second  
20 Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring, that  
21 the Governor investigate the feasibility of and the necessity of  
22 acquiring the Port of Whittier in order to protect other ports, and  
23 inquire into the possibility of the Port's use by private industry  
24 on lease from the state, into the state's acquiring and then sell-  
25 ing the Port for profit, and into the state's acquiring the Port  
26 for its own use.
