5 Relating to the late Anton Anderson.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
7 ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

8 WHEREAS, the Legislature has received the sad news of the
9 passing of one of Alaska's most distinguished pioneer citizens,
10 Anton Anderson; and

11 WHEREAS, the late Anton Anderson came to Alaska in 1917 and
12 filled the intervening years with distinguished private endeavor
13 and public service; and

14 WHEREAS, in addition to being a pioneer engineer in the forma-
15 tive years of the Territory he served with energy and distinction
16 in various development efforts in interior Alaska; and

17 WHEREAS, until illness prevented he served the City of
18 Anchorage with particular distinction as engineer, then as council-
19 man, and finally as mayor;

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in First Legislature, Second
21 Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring, that
22 the Legislature notes with sorrow the passing of a distinguished
23 Alaskan, Anton Anderson, who contributed so much to the develop-
24 ment of the state, and hereby expresses its sincerest condolences
25 to Mrs. Anton Anderson and her family on their loss which is also
26 a loss to the State of Alaska.
