SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 24

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to a study and proposals by
the local affairs agency.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
ASSEMBLED, THE HOUSE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, the Legislature is particularly cognizant of the
need for a thorough study of and sound proposals for the establish-
ment of borough government throughout the state before the Legis-
lature can take appropriate action to effectively respond to the
will and the needs of the people;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in First Legislature, Second
Session assembled, the House of Representatives concurring, that
the local affairs agency be and hereby is directed to conduct a
study on the establishment of organized boroughs and the integra-
tion of existing special districts into service areas in unorgan-
ized boroughs, to make such study in cooperation with the Legisla-
tive Council, and present the following to the next Legislature
within 10 days after the start of its first regular session:

(1) specific proposals for legislation to establish
boundaries of the first organized boroughs;

(2) specific proposals for legislation on organized
boroughs, including a draft of a general law on organized boroughs
which will provide for the organization and powers and duties of
organized boroughs, the integration of existing special districts
into their governments, and a system of assembly apportionment and
reapportionment for all organized boroughs; and

(3) specific proposals for legislation if determined necessary and proper, to integrate special districts into service areas in unorganized boroughs, the number of service areas to be kept to a minimum.
