10 Your Memorialist, the Senate of the State of Alaska, in
11 First Session assembled, respectfully submits that:

12 WHEREAS, the Port of Whittier, Alaska, is now under the
13 control of the United States Army; and

14 WHEREAS, the release of this port for commercial use would
15 make available a number of buildings for state institutional use;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, such a commercial port would bring industry into
18 the Whittier area and provide active payrolls for Alaskan
19 residents; and

20 WHEREAS, such expansion of industry could be to the benefit
21 of all Alaska:

22 NOW THEREFORE, Your Memorialist, the Senate of the State of
23 Alaska in First Session assembled respectfully urges that all
24 expedient steps be taken to release the facilities at the Port
25 of Whittier, Alaska, for commercial use.
