8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN FIRST
9 SESSION ASSEMBLED:

10 WHEREAS, the Honorable E. B. Collins, the Honorable Charles
11 Jones and the Honorable Henry Roden, residents of the State of
12 Alaska, were all members of the First Alaskan Territorial Legis-
13 lature which marked the beginning of a limited form of self-
14 government for Alaska and paved the way for eventual statehood;

16 WHEREAS, these three surviving members of that first Legis-
17 lature have been and are devoted Alaska citizens, each having
18 spent much time in the elective public service to the credit of
19 the Territory and the State of Alaska; and

20 WHEREAS, the members of the Senate of the First State Legis-
21 lature look with respect and appreciation to these true pioneers
22 of the First Territorial Legislature and their departed col-
23 leagues;

24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Senate of the State
25 of Alaska does hereby express on behalf of the people of Alaska
26 its genuine and heartfelt gratitude to Messrs. E. B. Collins of
27 Fairbanks, Charles Jones of Nome and Henry Roden of Juneau for
28 their fine service to Alaska and wishes each good health and many
29 years of prosperity and reward under statehood.
