BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN THE FIRST  
6 LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION ASSEMBLED:

10 coverage of the fast-moving and intricate legislative process if

WHEREAS, the First Session of the First State Legislature has  
16 enjoyed unprecedented coverage of its problems and work through  
17 comprehensive and conscientious news wire service coverage;
