SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 13

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the construction of an
airstrip at Pedro Bay

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, the community of Pedro Bay is without an airfield,
roads or any transportation facility except great distances by
water or dog sled in winter, and

WHEREAS, an airstrip at the village is necessary to the health,
welfare and economy, and would have great tourist potential, and

WHEREAS, in past years, engineers of the former Department of
Aviation have made tests and preliminary surveys determining that
a proposed landing strip at Pedro Bay is feasible, and

WHEREAS, said department has for years given priority to areas
already having airfields, thus by-passing Pedro Bay;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in First Legislature, Second
Session assembled, that the Governor of the State of Alaska and
the Commissioner of Public Works take necessary action during the
1960 season to complete preliminary studies and from the first
funds available to the Division of Aviation, not otherwise alloc-
ated, to construct an airstrip at Pedro Bay, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be sent to
the Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of Alaska; and the
Honorable Richard A. Downing, Commissioner of Public Works.
