5 Relating to the construction of air
6 strips in various Alaskan communities.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
8 ASSEMBLED:

9 WHEREAS, many small communities throughout Alaska are with-
10 out air fields, roads, or other transportation facilities; and

11 WHEREAS, in many cases air strips at these villages would
12 improve the health, welfare and economy, and would have great
13 potential value in the tourist trade; and

14 WHEREAS, the construction of air strips in these communities
15 would serve to reduce the cost of freight on the necessities of
16 life; and

17 WHEREAS, most of these communities have for many years made
18 efforts directed toward the construction of air strips; and

19 WHEREAS, in many cases preliminary studies have been made by
20 the former State Department of Aviation, but so far no actual
21 construction has been undertaken;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in First Legislature, Second
23 Session assembled, that the governor of the State of Alaska and
24 the commissioner of public works take necessary action during the
25 1960 construction season to complete, from the first funds avail-
26 able to the Division of Aviation, not otherwise allocated, con-
27 struction of air strips at New Stuyukuk, Pedro Bay, Perryville,
28 Clarks Point, Chignik, King Cove, Kodiak, Barrow, Old Harbor,
29 Alitak, Karluck, Afognak, Ouzinkie, Ninilchik, Soldotna,
