2d CS FOR SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 13
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the construction of air strips in various Alaskan communities.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, many small communities throughout Alaska are without air fields, roads, or other transportation facilities; and

WHEREAS, in many cases air strips at these villages would improve the health, welfare and economy, and would have great potential value in the tourist trade; and

WHEREAS, the construction of air strips in these communities would serve to reduce the cost of freight on the necessities of life; and

WHEREAS, most of these communities have for many years made efforts directed toward the construction of air strips; and

WHEREAS, in many cases preliminary studies have been made by the former State Department of Aviation, but so far no actual construction has been undertaken;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in First Legislature, Second Session assembled, that the governor of the State of Alaska and the commissioner of public works take necessary action during the 1960 construction season to complete, from the first funds available to the division of aviation, not otherwise allocated, construction of air strips at Chandalar Lake site, New Stuyukuk, Pedro Bay, Perryville, Clarks Point, Chignik, King Cove, Kodiak, Barrow, Old Harbor, Alitak, Karluk, Afognak, Ouzinkie, Ninilchik,

1 Soldotna, Kasilof, Fox River, Stebbins, Holy Cross, Kaltag,
2 Holikachuck, Egegik, Savoonga, Basin Creek extension, Shageluk, and
3 Anvik; and be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be sent to
5 the Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of Alaska; and the Honor-
6 able Richard A. Downing, Commissioner of Public Works.
