Relating to the reconstruction of the

footbridge across the Ninilchik River

at the village of Ninilchik.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION

ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, the footbridge crossing from the village of Ninilchik

11

over the Ninilchik River to the narrow peninsula of land on which

12

the Berman Packing Company and Cold Storage facilities are lo-

13

cated has fallen down and is, therefore, completely unusable; and

14

WHEREAS, the absence of the footbridge has made it necessary

15

for those Ninilchik residents who are employed at the packing

16

company's facilities to travel by a long and circuitous route of

17

several miles in order to reach the place of their employment at

18

the packing plant where approximately thirty-five workers are em-

19

ployed in the summer; and

20

WHEREAS, such a long and circuitous travel route, being ex-

21

pensive, time-consuming, and inconvenient, imposes an undue

22

hardship upon those residents of Ninilchik who are employed at

23

the packing plant;

24

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in First Legislature, Second

25

Session assembled, that the Governor of the State of Alaska and

26

the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works take such steps

27

as are necessary to rebuild and restore the fallen footbridge

28

across the Ninilchik River in order that the residents of

29

Ninilchik may once again have the use of their customary and

1 normal means of crossing the Ninilchik River; and be it

2 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
3 the Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of Alaska, and to the
4 Honorable Richard Downing, Commissioner of the Department of
5 Public Works.
