6 Vocational Education Executive
7 Committee.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
9 ASSEMBLED:

10 WHEREAS, it becomes increasingly apparent that there is a
11 real need for additional vocational education in the public school
12 system; and

13 WHEREAS, the federal government and several private founda-
14 tions have expressed an interest in the furtherance of vocational
15 education; and

16 WHEREAS, it is up to the state to investigate the possi-
17 bility of procuring grants-in-aid for the furtherance of vocation-
18 al education in this state;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate in First Legislature, Second
20 Session assembled, that a Vocational Education Executive Com-
21 mittee be formed to be composed of the secretary of state, as
22 chairman, a member of the staff of the Department of Education,
23 a faculty member of the University of Alaska, a member of the
24 legislature or from the state at large, and a member of the
25 educational staff of the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and be it

26 FURTHER RESOLVED that this committee determine the need, de-
27 sirability, feasibility, cost, benefits, and availability of grants
28 for vocational education from sources both public and private.
