HOUSE BILL NO. 11

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the compensation of members of the legislature; amending Secs. 1, 2, and 3, Ch. 1, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 1, Ch. 1, SLA 1959 is amended to read:

Section 1. LEGISLATIVE PER DIEM. The rate of per diem in lieu of subsistence and other expenses for each member of the Legislature while in session shall be \$20.00 [~~\$40.00~~] per day.

Sec. 2. Sec. 2, Ch. 1, SLA 1959 is amended to read:

Section 2. ANNUAL SALARIES. The annual salary for each member of the Legislature shall be \$1,200.00 [~~\$3,000.00~~], to be paid at the rate of \$100.00 [~~\$250.00~~] per month.

Sec. 3. Sec. 3, Ch. 1, SLA 1959 is amended to read:

Section 3. ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCES. In recognition of their extra duties the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House shall each be paid an additional allowance of \$300.00 [~~\$600.00~~] per year payable at the rate of \$25.00 per month during tenure of office. [THESE SUMS SHALL BE PAID AT THE RATE OF \$50.00 PER MONTH.]

Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
