

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 17,
AS AMENDED

Adopted by the Senate March 31, 1961

1. Page 8, line 1: Add the following sentence to follow the word "petition"

"Any person aggrieved by any determination of the Commission may appeal to the Superior Court in the manner and within the scope of review prescribed by Sections 24 and 25, Ch. 2, of the Administrative Procedure Act."

2. Page 8, line 12: After the word "board" insert ", and to determine whether the borough shall have an appointed borough manager or an elected borough chairman"

3. Page 10, line 12: After the period, insert "If the majority of votes cast on the question are in favor of an appointed borough manager, the secretary of state shall so certify and shall not certify any candidate as borough chairman. If the majority of votes cast on the question are not in favor of a borough manager, the secretary of state shall certify the name of the candidate who received the highest number of votes as borough chairman."

4. Page 10, lines 13 and 14: Delete all material on line 13 and through the word "the" on line 14

5. Page 11, line 24: After word "rules," insert word "resolution,"

6. Page 13, line 28: After word "established," insert "operated,"

7. Page 15, line 12: Add new sentences:

"Nothing in this section prevents any city from having a planning and zoning commission in an advisory capacity. Appointment of borough planning and zoning commission members from a first class city shall be made from the city advisory commission membership."

8. Page 28, line 10: Delete the word "An" and insert the following:

"In addition to the adoption of the borough manager plan at the time of incorporation, an"

9. Page 33, line 24: Add new sentence to Sec. 6.04:

"All borough elections shall be nonpartisan elections."

10. Page 43, line 14: Add a new section to read as follows:

"Sec. 8.02. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect October 1, 1961."
