6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the salaries of teachers,  
7 and other employees of public schools; re-  
8 pealing and re-enacting Secs. 37-6-1,  
9 37-6-2, and 37-6-3, ACLA 1949, as repealed  
10 and re-enacted by Ch. 179, SLA 1957; and  
11 providing for an effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. Sec. 37-6-1, ACLA 1949, as repealed and re-enacted  
14 by Ch. 179, SLA 1957 is repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

15 Sec. 37-6-1. TEACHERS' SALARY SCALE BY SENATE DISTRICT.

16 a. the school boards of school districts in the State of  
17 Alaska and the state Department of Education as the operating  
18 agency for schools outside school districts shall pay regu-  
19 larly qualified teachers employed by them a salary not less  
20 than that set forth in the following scale:

21 (1) SOUTHEASTERN SENATE DISTRICT.

9 (2) SOUTHCENTRAL SENATE DISTRICT. In the South-  
10 central Senate District, the amount of \$400 shall be added to  
11 each step of the Southeastern Senate District salary scale.

12 (3) CENTRAL AND NORTHWEST SENATE DISTRICTS AND  
13 THAT PART OF THE SOUTHCENTRAL SENATE DISTRICT LYING WEST OF  
14 152° WEST LONGITUDE. In the Central and Northwest Senate  
15 Districts and in that part of the Southcentral Senate District  
16 lying West of 152° West Longitude, the amount of \$700 shall  
17 be added to each step of the Southeastern Senate District  
18 salary scale.

19 b. Not more than four years public school experience  
20 outside Alaska may be substituted for a like period of public  
21 school experience in Alaska when a teacher's position on the  
22 salary scale is established.

23 Sec. 2. Sec. 37-6-2, ACLA 1949 as repealed and re-enacted by  
24 Ch. 179, SLA 1957 is repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

25 Sec. 37-6-2. SUPERINTENDENT'S SALARY SCALE BY SENATE  
26 DISTRICT. a. The school boards of school districts in the  
27 State of Alaska and the state Department of Education as the  
28 operating agency for schools outside school districts shall  
29 pay regularly qualified superintendents employed by them a

22 to each step of the Southeastern Senate District salary  
23 scale.

24 (3) CENTRAL AND NORTHWEST SENATE DISTRICT AND  
25 THAT PART OF THE SOUTHCENTRAL SENATE DISTRICT LYING WEST OF  
26 152° WEST LONGITUDE. In the Central and Northwest Senate  
27 Districts and in that part of the Southcentral Senate Dis-  
28 trict lying west of 152° West Longitude, the amount of \$800  
29 shall be added to each step of the Southeastern Senate

b. Not more than four years public school administrative experience outside Alaska may be substituted for a like period of public school administrative experience in Alaska when a superintendent's position on the salary scale is established.  
Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1961.
