SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the salaries of teachers, and other employees of public schools; re-pealing and re-enacting Secs. 37-6-1, 37-6-2, and 37-6-3, ACLA 1949, as repealed and re-enacted by Ch. 179, SLA 1957; and providing an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 37-6-1, ACLA 1949, as repealed and re-enacted by Ch. 179, SLA 1957 is repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 37-6-1. TEACHERS' SALARY SCALE BY SENATE DISTRICT.

a. The school boards of school districts in the State of Alaska shall pay regularly qualified teachers employed by them a salary not less than that set forth in the following scale:

(1) SOUTHEASTERN SENATE DISTRICT.

7 (2) SOUTHCENTRAL SENATE DISTRICT. In the South-  
8 central Senate District, the amount of \$400 shall be added to  
9 each step of the Southeastern Senate District salary scale.

10 (3) CENTRAL AND NORTHWEST SENATE DISTRICTS AND  
11 THAT PART OF THE SOUTHCENTRAL SENATE DISTRICT LYING WEST OF  
12 152° WEST LONGITUDE. In the Central and Northwest Senate  
13 Districts and in that part of the Southcentral Senate District  
14 lying West of 152° West Longitude, the amount of \$700 shall  
15 be added to each step of the Southeastern Senate District  
16 salary scale.

17 b. The state Department of Education as the operating  
18 agency for schools outside school districts shall pay  
19 regularly qualified teachers employed by the state a salary  
20 not less than \$500 per year above the salary set out in  
21 paragraph a. of this section.

22 c. Not more than four years public school experience  
23 outside Alaska may be substituted for a like period of public  
24 school experience in Alaska when a teacher's position on the  
25 salary scale is established.

26 Sec. 2. Sec. 37-6-2, ACLA 1949 as repealed and re-enacted by  
27 Ch. 179, SLA 1957 is repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

28 Sec. 37-6-2. SUPERINTENDENT'S SALARY SCALE BY SENATE  
29 DISTRICT. a. The school boards of school districts in the

1 State of Alaska shall pay regularly qualified superintendents  
2 employed by them a salary not less than that set forth in the  
3 following scale:

22 central Senate District, the amount of \$500 shall be added  
23 to each step of the Southeastern Senate District salary scale.

24 (3) CENTRAL AND NORTHWEST SENATE DISTRICT AND THAT  
25 PART OF THE SOUTHCENTRAL SENATE DISTRICT LYING WEST OF 152°  
26 WEST LONGITUDE. In the Central and Northwest Senate Districts  
27 and in that part of the Southcentral Senate District lying  
28 west of 152° West Longitude, the amount of \$800 shall be  
29 added to each step of the Southeastern Senate District

1 salary scale.

2 b. The state Department of Education as the operating  
3 agency for schools outside school districts shall pay  
4 regularly qualified superintendents employed by the state a  
5 salary not less than \$500 per year above the salary set out  
6 in paragraph a. of this section.

7 c. Not more than four years public school administrative  
8 experience outside Alaska may be substituted for a like period  
9 of public school administrative experience in Alaska when a  
10 superintendent's position on the salary scale is established.

11 Sec. 3. Sec. 37-6-3, ACLA 1949 as repealed and re-enacted  
12 by Ch. 179, SLA 1957 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

13 Sec. 37-6-3. AMOUNTS ESTABLISHED ABOVE SALARY SCALE FOR  
14 PRINCIPALS, VICE-PRINCIPALS, HEAD TEACHERS, AND TEACHERS-IN-  
15 CHARGE. The school boards of school districts within the  
16 state and the state Department of Education as the operating  
17 agency for schools outside school districts shall pay  
18 regularly qualified principals, vice-principals, head teachers,  
19 and teachers-in-charge employed by them a salary which shall  
20 be not less than the allowable salary for the Senate District  
21 in which employed plus the following amounts:

22	Teacher-in-Charge	\$200
23	Head Teacher	400
24	Vice-Principal	400
25	Principal	800

26 Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1961.
