IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to elections; amending
Ch. 83, SLA 1960."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA;

Section 1. Sec. 3.03(5), Ch. 83, SLA 1960 is repealed and
re-enacted to read:

(5) The general election ballot shall be printed
on white paper with the names of each candidate and their
party designations placed in separate sections under the
office designation to which they were nominated. The party
affiliation, if any, shall be designated after the name of
the candidate. The secretary of state and governor shall
be included under the same section. Provision shall be made
for voting for write-in and no-party candidates within each
section.

Sec. 2. Sec. 5.06, Ch. 83, SLA 1960 is repealed and re-
enacted to read:

Sec. 5.06. PREPARATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF BALLOTS.
The primary nomination ballot shall be prepared and distributed
by the secretary of state in the manner prescribed for the
general election ballots, except as specifically provided other-
wise for the primary nomination. The secretary of state shall
place the names of all candidates who have properly filed and
their party designation in separate sections under the office
designations to which they were nominated. The party affiliation,

1 if any, shall be designated after the name of the candidate.
2 Within each office the name of each candidate shall be rotated
3 as provided for the general election ballot.

4 Sec. 3. Sec. 3.36(10), Ch. 83, SLA 1960 is repealed.
