6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to prescribe minimum wage and over-
7 time compensation standards for employees
8 to be known as the "Alaska Wage and Hour
9 Act"; amending Secs. 2(1)(k), 3(1), and
10 4, Ch. 171, SLA 1959; and providing for an
11 effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. Sec. 2(1)(k), Ch. 171, SLA 1959 is amended to
14 read:

15 (k) any individual, under sixteen [EIGHTEEN] years of
16 age employed on a part-time basis not more than 20 hours in
17 any week.

18 Sec. 2. Sec. 3(1), Ch. 171, SLA 1959 is amended to read:

19 (1) any employer employing less than two employees
20 [EMPLOYEE EXEMPT UNDER SEC. 13(a), (b) and (c) OF THE FAIR
21 LABOR STANDARDS ACT OF 1938, AS AMENDED];

22 Sec. 3. Sec. 4, Ch. 171, SLA 1959 is amended to read:

23 Sec. 4. MINIMUM WAGES. Every employer, except as may
24 be otherwise provided in this Act, shall pay to each of his
25 employees wages at a rate of not less than \$1.75 [\$1.50] an
26 hour.

27 Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
28 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
