BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 1, Ch. 1, SLA 1959 is amended to read:

Section 1. LEGISLATIVE PER DIEM. The rate of per diem
in lieu of subsistence and other expenses for each member of
the Legislature while in session shall range from \$1.00 to
[BE] \$40.00 per day inclusive. On the day this Act takes
effect and on the first day of each subsequent regular or
special session each legislator shall certify in writing to
the legislative fiscal officer the amount of per diem within
the limits set forth in this section which he feels his
services as a legislator for his constituents and the state
are worth. He shall be paid that amount for the remainder of
the session.

Section 2. ANNUAL SALARIES. The annual salary for each
member of the Legislature shall range from \$1.00 to [BE]
\$3,000.00 inclusive, to be paid at the rate within that range
that the member certifies to the legislative fiscal officer
as the amount he feels his services as a legislator for his
constituents and the state are worth [OF \$250.00 PER MONTH].
