6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the disposition of cer-
7 tain fisheries taxes; amending Ch. 66, SLA
8 1953."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Sec. 1, Ch. 66, SLA 1953 is amended to read:

11 Section 1. The commissioner of revenue [TAX COMMISSION-
12 ER] shall pay to each incorporated municipality, incorporated
13 or independent school district, and public utility district
14 in the state [TERRITORY], within the boundaries of which a
15 salmon cannery, herring processing plant, bottom fish pro-
16 cessing plant, crab cannery, shrimp cannery, or clam cannery
17 is operated, ten percentum of the amount of tax revenue col-
18 lected under the provisions of Section 1 (a), [AND] 1 (a)(1),
19 1 (b), 1 (c), and 1 (d) of Chapter 82, Session Laws of
20 Alaska 1949, as amended by Chapter 113, SLA 1951, from within
21 such municipality or district. Where a [SALMON] cannery or
22 other processing plant is located within overlapping areas of
23 a municipality and district or of districts, the ten percent
24 payment provided hereunder shall be divided equally between
25 such political subdivisions within which the cannery or
26 processing plant is so located. The payment shall be made
27 annually on or before April 1st of each year and based on the
28 tax collected for the preceding calendar year [, PROVIDED
29 THAT THE FIRST PAYMENT SHALL BE MADE APRIL 1, 1954, FROM THE
